

TOWN OF GOSHEN MEETING CONCERNING PROPOSED
SEWER DISTRICT

A petition of twenty or more voters having been presented to the Selectmen, a meeting of the electors and those qualified to vote in town meetings who reside within the limits of the District of the Town of Goshen hereinafter described will be held at the Town Planning Office in the municipal building in said Town on Friday, July 17, 1970, at 8:00 P.M. for the following purposes:

1. To consider and act upon a proposal to establish a district encompassing the hereinafter described area for the construction and maintenance of sewers to serve said district, all in accordance with the provisions of Title 7, Chapter 105 of the General Statutes of Connecticut, Revision of 1958, as amended. The proposed district is described as follows:

The certain piece or parcel of land, bounded as follows:

- Northerly - In part by Milton Road and in part by Connecticut State Highway Route 4;
- Easterly - By Beach Street;
- Southerly and Easterly - By land now or formerly of Henry B. Mosle;
- Southerly - By Ives Road;
- Easterly, Northerly, Easterly, Northerly, Easterly, Southerly, Easterly, Northerly and again Easterly - by land now or formerly of Marshall Thorn, et ux;
- Southerly - By land now or formerly of Barnett Laschever;
- Westerly and Southerly - By land now or formerly of Edgar Crossman;
- Westerly - In part by land of the City of Waterbury, the Marshepaug River; and
- Southerly - By the discontinued Marshepaug Road; and

Westerly - by Milton Road;
Southerly - By land now or formerly of Frances Roraback;
Westerly - By Connecticut State Forest land;
Northerly - By Forest Road, so-called; and
Westerly - By Milton Road.

2. To choose a name for the District, if formed, and choose the necessary officers therefor to hold office until the first annual meeting thereof.

3. To consider the adoption of an ordinance fixing the date of the annual meeting of the voters for the election of District officers and transaction of such other business as may properly come before such annual meeting.
