

WOODRIDGE LAKE SEWER DISTRICT
WHO CAN VOTE IN SPECIAL DISTRICT MEETING

(Governed by Chapter 105 of the Connecticut General Statutes)

A VOTER IS DEFINED AS FOLLOWS:

A property owner who is:

1. 18 years of age or older, **and**
2. A citizen of the United States, **and**
3. Is liable to the District for taxes on an assessment of \$1,000 or more on the last completed District grand list, or would have liable if an exemption had not been applied, is entitled to vote.

OR

A resident of Woodridge Lake who is registered to vote in the Town of Goshen.

NOTE:

A property owner who owns multiple properties gets one vote in total. A property owned by multiple persons entitles each person to vote if the person meets the property owner test described above - 18 years old, citizen and liable (jointly or severally) for taxes on \$1,000 of assessed property on last grand list.

Only natural persons may vote. If a property is owned by a trust, limited liability company (LLC), corporation or other legal entity, that legal entity may not vote; neither can a trustee or beneficiary of a trust, a member of an LLC or an officer or shareholder of a corporation. If, however, any of these persons is a resident of the District and a registered voter in the Town of Goshen, that person may vote.

Proxies and absentee ballots are **NOT** permitted.

Each voter must present identification (e.g., a valid photo ID) before voting.

Property owners who do not appear on the District's listing of property owners can sign an Affidavit of Property Owner Eligible to Vote, which will allow them to vote at the Special District Meeting.
