

Invitation for Bids (IFB)  
2017 Sewer Pipe Lining Project  
Woodridge Lake Sewer District (Goshen, CT)

Woodridge Lake Sewer District (WLSLD) is requesting bids from qualified pipe lining contractors. The work consists of cured-in-place pipe lining of 2,000 feet of 8-inch sanitary sewer piping, as well as three short liners, grouting of one service lateral, and reinstating a tap from prior lining. The Invitation for Bids (IFB) will be available on July 24, 2017. Proposals will be accepted by the Woodridge Lake Sewer District (WLSLD), at its WPCF office at 113 Brush Hill Road, Goshen CT 06756 until 10:00 AM on Thursday, August 17, 2017. Bids should be labelled "IFP: 2017 Sewer Pipe Lining Project," followed by the bidder's company name, address and contact name. Late bids will be rejected. Immediately following the bid deadline, bids will be publicly opened. All bidders shall furnish with their bid a mandatory bid guarantee in the form of a bid bond, certified check, treasurer's check, a bid deposit, or cashier's check issued by a responsible bank or trust company in the amount of 5% of the total amount of the bid made payable to Woodridge Lake Sewer District. Wages are subject to State of Connecticut as per Connecticut General Statutes. Performance and Payment Bonds, in the full amount of the contract price, will be required of the successful bidder. No Bid may be withdrawn within thirty (30) days after the date of the opening of bids. All bids received will be evaluated and awarded in accordance with the provisions established under Connecticut State Statutes, amended and the Terms and Conditions set forth by WLSLD.
